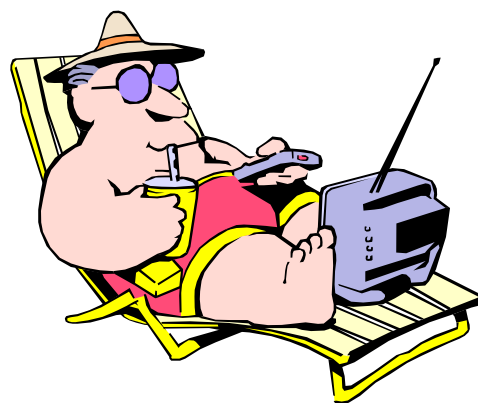

KIT

Please ensure that as a minimum requirement that the following kit is brought along to camp: Bible*, 3 Towels, Pyjamas, Bathing trunks, Socks, Sportswear, Underwear, Changes of Clothing, Toiletries, Raincoat, Comb, Heavy Shoes, Shoe Polish, Torch, Plastic Bag for Dirty Clothes, Spare plastic bags

for return home. * Required for Tent Inspection.

NOTE: Every boy should bring three dishtowels. It should be noted that these will not be returned therefore do not bring brand new dishtowels.

INSURANCE

The Boys' Brigade Insurance policy does not cover loss or damage to Cameras, Personal Stereos, IPOD's, Mobile Phones, Etc. These items are brought along at YOUR OWN RISK.

EMERGENCY CONTACT

LOADING AND UNLOADING THE LORRY

All boys and parents are asked to assist with the loading and unloading of the lorry at Cambusnethan North Church on Thursday 23rd June and Saturday 2nd July. We would ask for your cooperation and help to ensure we complete this as quickly as possible.

CAMP BANK & TUCK SHOP

We would strongly recommend that all spending money is deposited into the Camp Bank as the Companies cannot be held responsible for any loss of money not deposited in the Camp Bank. Money will be issued on a daily basis, however no boy will be issued more money than he is allocated for a day, this alleviates the problem of boys running out of money.

The camp will have a fully stocked tuck shop selling a selection of sweets, crisps and soft drinks. The tuck shop operates on a no money basis; money should be deposited into the tuck shop account if you wish to use this facility. Money can be transferred to your tuck shop account at anytime.

FOOD SAFETY

Food at camp has over the years improved and we make every effort to ensure that the food is prepared properly, cooked adequately and is served safely. In order to ensure that we keep our food safe, everyone attending camp should be aware of the need for good food safety and practice. Your co-operation and personal cleanliness will allow us to have safe food at camp therefore it is very important that you follow all instructions regarding hand washing, food preparation and cleaning up given by any member of staff. Our Camp Cook and C.O. has undergone training in Food Hygiene and holds an Elementary Food Hygiene Certificate issued by The Royal Environmental Health Institute of Scotland, he has been cooking at BB Camps for many years and has a wealth of experience in cooking for large groups.

REMEMBER YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR EVERYONES FOOD SAFETY

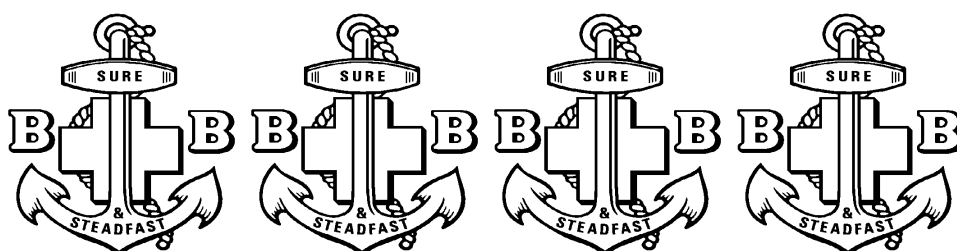
***Anyone with health related diet requirements should discuss

VISITING CAMP

Parents and family are welcome to visit their sons at the Camp at any time, however prior arrangement should be made with the staff beforehand as your date and time of visit may coincide with a planned visit or activity.

CAMP RULES

1. Permission must be received before going boating or swimming, this will only be granted where adequate supervision is available.
2. When out in town make sure you are properly dressed and remember at all times that you are members of The Boys' Brigade.
3. When out walking ensure you are not trespassing.
4. All boys **MUST** be on time for meals.
5. All boys **MUST** be back at the Camp Site at the time set out by the Commanding Officer.
6. Keep the Camp Site and surrounding grounds clean and tidy at all times by using the bins provided.
7. No smoking within Camp Site.
8. Equipment must not be misused. All breakages should be reported.
9. Gambling will not be tolerated.
10. Consumption or possession of alcohol in any shape or form will result in the strongest disciplinary action.
11. Possession of drugs in any shape or form will be dealt with through the authorities for such matters. All medication **MUST** be given to the medical officer prior to camp. **Under no circumstances should boys be in possession of any prescribed or non-prescribed medicines.**
12. Petty theft cannot be countenanced and will as required be dealt with by the Police.
13. Late passes will be at the discretion of the Commanding Officer.
14. Tents must be kept tidy at all times.
15. No boy irrespective of age should leave or return to the Camp Site alone.
16. Permission should be received before leaving the Camp Site in the morning or at any other time stated by the Commanding Officer.
17. Breach of the above rules could result in further action being taken by relevant Company Captains and / or relevant authorities where appropriate.
18. When travelling in any vehicle, seat belts must be worn at all times.
19. This list is not endless; use common sense and good manners at all times.
20. **THE COMMANDING OFFICER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEND ANY BOY HOME.**
