## Section Meetings

The boys and officers of 2nd Cambusnethan Company & Senior Sections meet on Friday nights from 7pm until 9:30pm in the halls of Wishaw Cambusnethan North Parish Church on Cambusnethan Street. There is a tuck shop open to the boys during the night.

In the interests of safety we would recommend that all boys should be dropped off at the Church and collected from the Church at the end of the night.



## Section Night Activities

During the evening all boys take part in a variety of activities from games to badge/award work (see below), to competition work. Each Boy should therefore bring with them a PT kit to change into for their games and sports sessions.

Throughout the four years in the Company Section the boys will work their way through the Discover Award Programme. This programme involves the boys working in a variety of tasks and activities aimed at three specific zones which are as follows:

- Skills
- Recreation
- Community

If worked through successfully the boys will earn one badge for each zone available at four levels (one level per year); in addition to the above there is also the opportunity to gain the Compass Award in the first year and the Discovery Award in the second year.



## Church Attendance

A vital part of the Boys' Brigade work centers around the spiritual life of the boys. We expect that each boy attends a Church based activity on a regular basis.

Cambusnethan North Church has Sunday services from 11am, parents, family, friends and members of the company are welcome to attend.

Attendance at the BB Discovery Group, which is held in the Church hall at 6.30pm on Sunday Evenings is actively encouraged, as this brings together the Junior Section, Company Section, Seniors and Officers in a fun informal Christian based time of praise and worship.

In addition to Sunday worship attendance, we also expect the boys to attend all the Company and Battalion parades in the year, this usually involves three Company parades (Enrolment Service, Remembrance Sunday and Palm Sunday) and two Battalion parades (Founders Day and the End of Session Event). Church attendance, in which ever form, counts towards the boys service badge at the end of the year.

## National Competitions

Throughout the year we also take part in as many as possible of the competitions organised by the Boys' Brigade Scotland. At present the competitions that are held are as follows;
